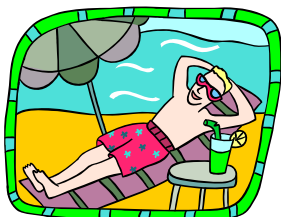


Dilhorne Endowed Summer Term 2011 Newsletter
